Understanding Mediterranean multi-taxa 'bycatch' of vulnerable species and testing mitigation - a collaborative approach



MAIN OUTPUTS



A unique methodology in the Mediterranean and the Black Sea to monitor the incidental catch of vulnerable species (seabirds, marine mammals, sea turtles, cartilaginous fishes, coral and sponges)

Data collection across more than 40 ports in 3 Mediterranean countries through onboard observations, self-reporting and questionnaires at landing places, covering different bottom fishing gears (longlines, trawls, gillnets) and purse seines





First regional review on bycatch of vulnerable species and first regional database **for better knowledge sharing** in the Mediterranean & the Black Sea

Bycatch mitigation measures defined through regional and national partnerships supported, by a scientific committee
